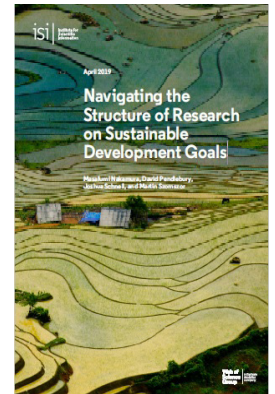

The global research landscape of the SDGs analyzed and evaluated

The Web of Science group recently released the report [Navigating the Structure of Research on Sustainable Development Goals](#) which studies the “representation” of the SDGs in the Web of Science database. The publication analyzes 20,000 scholarly journals and conference proceedings, revealing a map of the SDGs in the global research landscape and evaluating the academic impact of the research.

The complex web of relationships and dependencies that the theme of sustainability presents can be captured, investigated, and visualized through research papers that address specific problems and refer to each other. These references, importantly provided by experts, offer us with shape and substance, texture and colour. The citation network, when mapped, reveals much of interest and of consequence for policy makers. (p. 14)

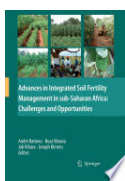
