DID YOU KNOW?

Creating citation notes and bibliographies in FAO citation style in Word

FAO employees can download a plugin for Word which creates in-text and endnotes in the FAO citation style importing citations from [EndNote online](#), the citation management tool included in the [Web of Science](#).

To get started you need to register for the Web of Science and start creating your personal library of citations in EndNote. Subsequently you can download from CIO's free application catalog the "Endnote" plugin. Once done your Word version will contain a new EndNote tab which will allow you to speed up the process of generating citation notes and bibliographies.

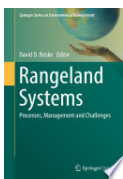
