Digesting the news: Colleagues in headquarters can now read print copies of major international newspapers

Therefore the Library started a new service providing colleagues with access to a selection of daily and weekly newspapers in print: The New York Times, Le Monde Diplomatique, El País and Financial Times - for those breaks in which you want to concentrate on and digest the news.

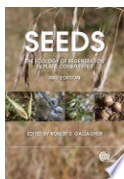
The newspapers can be read inside the study area of the FAO library and are positioned on the desks in front of the entrance. For older issues, just pass by the Library office in A012bis.



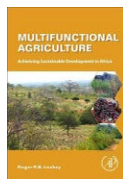
