On display this month in the Library the Latin commentary on the metaphysics of Aristotle by the Spanish theologian Antonius Andreas, an incunabulum from 1481. This rare book was donated to FAO by Marquise Raffaele Capelli, an Italian politician who played a key role in the agrarian reform of the early twentieth century.
