Peer-reviewed research and research libraries continue to be a trusted guide during times of uncertainty. In response to the challenges created by the global public health crisis of Covid-19, many publishers and libraries are making scholarly content temporarily available for free on their platforms.

Major publishers as Cambridge, Karger, OUP, Elsevier and many others are enabling fast and direct access to the latest available research, evidence, and data on Covid-19. Other publishers like Project MUSE, MIT Press and John Libbey among others are opening up temporarily big parts of their collections to the public. 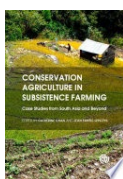

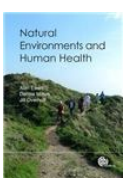

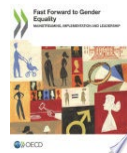
