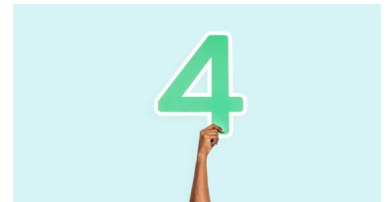

Now that Phase 4 has started, the FAO Library at headquarters has put, in compliance with the overall safety measures, the following arrangements in place:

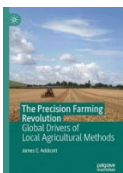
- To check-out or consult publications, write us at fao-library-loans@fao.org to make an appointment for pick-up.
