The Library provides access to *Africa Confidential* and *African Research Online*. FAO staff can access both resources through the Library's EZproxy from any computer or location.

[Africa Confidential](#)

Since 1960, *Africa Confidential* has been providing in-depth news and analysis of political, economic and security issues from across the continent. Contributors publish anonymously, submitting on-the-ground coverage of issues often before they are picked up by mainstream media. News is organized by country, by category (e.g. 'Agriculture') and by region. New issues are published every two weeks.



[African Research Online](#)

A set of two African studies resources: *African Studies Companion Online* and *Africa Yearbook Online*. Staff can set up personal accounts to save their searches and/or share entries on social media.

[African Studies Companion Online](#) is a 'live' online textbook containing over 1800 curated links and guides to African news outlets, language resources, libraries and archives, film resources, African studies programs worldwide and many other topics. Entries link directly to the Internet and are being updated continuously.

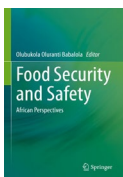


[Africa Yearbook Online](#) is an annual digest of domestic politics, foreign affairs, and socio-economic developments in Sub-Sahara Africa. Sections are organized into four sub-regions (West, Central, Eastern, Southern Africa) and by individual country. It also contains articles on major cross-border developments, one article on overall continental developments, and one article on European-African relations. Volumes include tables of facts about each country (heads of state, population, currency, HDI, etc.) The yearbook has been published every year since 2004.

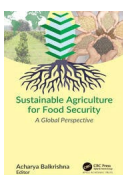

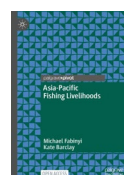

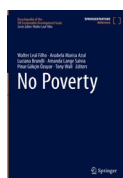
