Writing tools: The Chicago Manual of Style & The Oxford English Dictionary



FAO Library provides access to [The Chicago Manual of Style](#) and [The Oxford English Dictionary](#), two excellent resources for writers.

The Oxford English Dictionary is commonly regarded as the preeminent authority on the English language. It includes the definition, history, and pronunciation of over 600,000 words. Users can browse words by subject, usage, region, or origin. It includes a historical thesaurus and a timeline identifying when specific words and concepts entered the English language, for example *farming* was first used in 1050, spelled *feormunge*.

The Chicago Manual of Style is an invaluable resource on English grammar and usage. Here, you can find answers to small but time-consuming questions, such as: How do you cite a book with a bilingual title?

These tools can be accessed through the FAO Intranet. Under Information Resources, click on "Library". Click on "complete overview" and scroll to the section "Other full-text resources" or simply paste the URLs of the resources in the browse box of the Secure Access Gateway.
