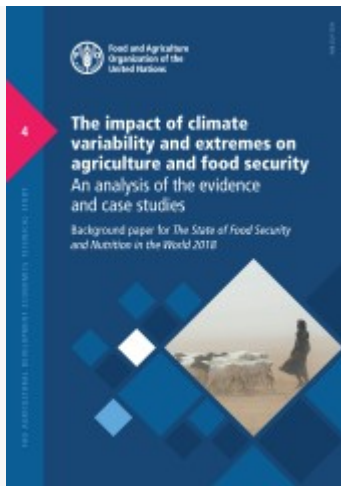
Empowering young agri-entrepreneurs to invest in agriculture and food systems

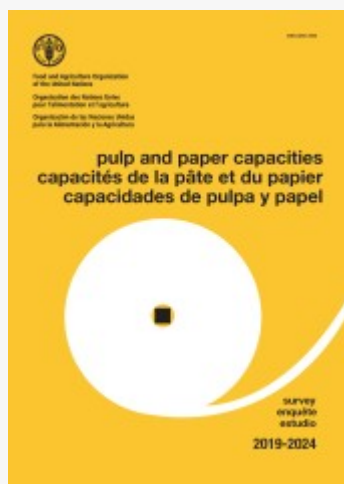
