

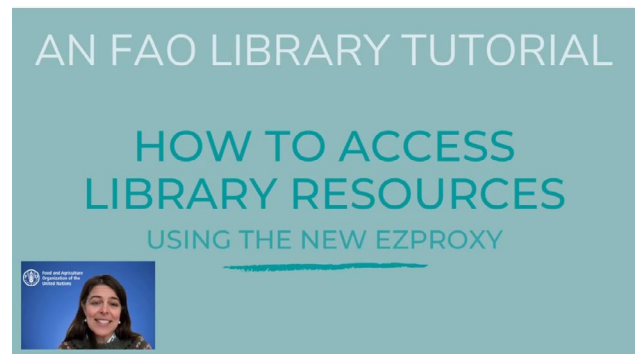

The Library team is in the process of creating a series of tutorial videos covering the various resources available for staff, the EZproxy video is one of them. They will become available through the you@fao platform this summer.



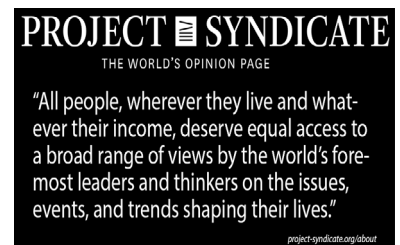
