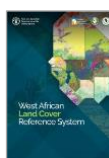


**Africa Open Data for Environment, Agriculture and Land (DEAL) and Africa's Great Green Wall – Technical land use support**

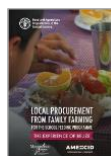


**West African Land Cover Reference System**
