



Hunger Hotspots – FAO-WFP early warnings on acute food insecurity: October 2022 to January 2023 Outlook

This report indicates that targeted humanitarian action is urgently needed to save lives and livelihoods in the 19 hunger hotspots. In six of these hotspots in particular – Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan and Yemen – humanitarian actions are critical in preventing further starvation and death.

As of 23 August 2022, the estimated number of internally displaced persons (IDPs) within Ukraine has increased to 6.9 million. The revised Rapid Response Plan (RRP) requires USD 115.4 million to assist 979 320 people in rural areas through December 2022.



These reports on the EAF used the diagnostic tool to assess the alignment of selected policy and legal instruments of the countries with an EAF. These assessments analyse the extent to which 82 EAF legal requirements, which are considered the minimum standards in legislating for an EAF, are reflected in the countries' policies and legislation relevant to the fisheries sector of the country and other relevant sectors (such as environment, wildlife, ecosystems, and maritime affairs).
