
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FAO Food Price Index

The FAO Food Price Index (FFPI) averaged 132.4 points in December 2022, down 2.6 points (1.9 percent) from November, marking the ninth consecutive monthly decline and standing 1.3 points (1.0 percent) below its value a year ago. The decline in the index in December was driven by a steep drop in the international prices of vegetable oils, along with some declines in cereal and meat prices, but partially counterbalanced by moderate increases in sugar and dairy products. For 2022 as a whole, however, the FFPI averaged 143.7 points, up from 2021 by as many as 18 points, or 14.3 percent.



FAO Cereal Supply and Demand Brief


FAO's forecast for world cereal production in 2022 has been cut by 7.2 million tonnes this month and is now pegged at 2 756 tonnes, 2.0 percent (57 million tonnes) lower year-on-year. By comparison, world cereal production grew by an average of 56 million tonnes per year in the last three years. This month's decline mainly concerns maize and, albeit by a smaller amount, wheat production.
